Important Update for Chamber Members: Facts You Should Know: New Legislation Impacting Businesses Local Legislation South San Francisco Minimum Wage Increase: • Effective January 1, 2024, the minimum wage in South San Francisco has increased to \$17.25 per hour. Applies to all businesses within the city limits and any employee working at least two or more hours per week (SSF). **State Legislation**  California Fast Food Worker Minimum Wage (AB 1228): • As of April 1, 2024, fast food workers at national chains with over 60 locations must receive at least \$20 per hour. Establishment of the Fast Food Council to set standards for wages and working conditions Expanded Paid Sick Leave (SB 616): • Effective January 1, 2024, increases paid sick leave from three days (24 hours) to five days (40 hours) per year for eligible employees. · Requires employers to update their leave policies to comply with new accrual and carryover limits Leave for Reproductive Loss (SB 848): • Provides five unpaid leave days for employees experiencing reproductive loss events, effective January 1, 2024.

- Applies to events such as failed adoption, failed surrogacy, miscarriage, stillbirth, or unsuccessful assisted reproduction
- Workplace Violence Prevention Plans (SB 553):
  - Requires most employers to develop comprehensive workplace violence prevention plans by July 1, 2024.
  - Plans must include procedures for reporting violence, communication strategies, and employee training



June is Men's Health Month Why men's health matters

When it comes to the health of the men in your life, you might play a bigger role than you think. Recent studies suggest that when men have health concerns, they often turn to loved ones before seeing a doctor.

- Men go to the doctor less frequently than women do. Only 62% of men say they've had
  contact with a doctor or other health care professional in the last 6 months, compared to
  74% of women, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
- When health issues arise, men often go to their significant others. And more men do so
  than women: 32% of men and 25% of women look to their partner for advice first, rather
  than a doctor or anyone else. So, when the men in your life turn to you for guidance, here
  are some quick tips to keep in mind:
  - Stress. Career demands and financial pressures contribute to stress among men. Stressors can lead to burnout, anxiety, and other mental health issues.
  - Know when to schedule a checkup. Healthy men under age 30 see their primary care
    doctor every 2 to 3 years. Men ages 30 to 40 should go every other year. And we
    strongly recommend men over age 50 go every year.
  - Get a good night's sleep. Research shows that poor sleep can have a negative impact on health in many ways. Sleep loss can cause increased inflammation in your body, which can elevate your risk of cardiovascular disease.
  - Partner up on your fitness. Being active can help you stay healthy, control your weight, and get the most out of life. No matter what your age or condition, there is a type of exercise that's right for you.

Men have unique health concerns. Our care teams can teach you about everything from hair loss to information on Prostate Cancer. Prioritizing one's health leads to a longer, healthier life.
